Welcome Back

Our program includes early learning activities, a craft, circle time and story time. By participating in these activities with your child, you help them to develop their learning and social skills. ELECT – Early Learning for Every Child Today

You will notice around the room different activity cards that explain what your child is learning while playing at the various centres. Staff will be implementing the ELECT framework in our programs. The activities promote child development in the following 5 domains, 1. Social 2. Emotional, 3. Communication, Language and Literacy, 4. Cognitive and 5. Physical. In January and February we will be focusing on Communication, Language and Literacy. We will have puzzle pieces out that tell you what your child is learning in this domain as an infant, toddler, preschool age and school age child. Please ask staff if you have any questions about ELECT.
