
Learning Math...

Baby

Peek-a-boo, Patty-cake, music/rhythm, rhymes & fingerplays, building and knocking down blocks, simple puzzles, sorting & stacking.

Toddler

Counting (steps, stairs, buttons on shirt), shapes (find shapes, inside & outside), filling containers, following simple instructions, What comes first, second, third?, sorting (clothes, toys, groceries), singing and music.

Preschooler

Counting & matching number of objects to number, shapes & sizes, simple measuring, following simple recipe with help from adult, patterns (music & objects), more & less, dramatic play (store), puzzles, recognize words on, in, on top.
